

## **UWA HOCKEY ACADEMY PROGRAM MODULES 2009**

The UWA Coaching Academy was established in January 2009 following a workshop and discussion with key stakeholders in the hockey community.

The Objective of the UWA Coaching Academy is to develop a wide range of coaching programs for hockey players based at the Superturf and supported by the resources of the University of WA, the UWA Hockey Club and other hockey stakeholders. It has been recognized by all that some of the programs will initially focus on the UWA Hockey Club as we trial and develop successful programs.

The following program modules are being established for 2009.

### **Module 1 – Coaching Clinics:**

Coordinator – Craig Boyce (ph 0447 971 631)

Superturf Program

Conduct hockey coaching clinics at the Superturf for the WA junior hockey community during the April, July and October school holidays.

The program will use coaches from the UWA Hockey Club as well as WAIS and senior representative players.

### **Module 2 – Goalkeeper Coaching Clinics:**

Superturf Program

Conduct hockey goalkeeper coaching clinics at the Superturf for the WA junior hockey community during the April, July and October school holidays. Programs will also be conducted at other times as demand from clubs and goalkeepers dictates.

### **Module 3 – Elite Junior Coaching Program:**

Joint Superturf and UWA Hockey club program.

The UWA Hockey Club and the Superturf will support this program to be run by Trid Woodhouse. The Superturf will receive turf hire income from the program.

It is envisaged that this program will be expanded to all junior hockey players over time and the financial model may change.

### **Module 4 – Advanced Skills Development Program:**

UWA Hockey Club program

This program has been initially established for UWA hockey club men and women between 16 and 20 years old who aspire to play first division and senior representative hockey. The cost of the program will be funded by the UWA Hockey Club at this stage.

It is envisaged that this program will be expanded to other clubs over time and the financial model will change.

**Module 5 – Day Camp Program:**

Coordinator - Craig Boyce and Trid Woodhouse

Superturf Program

This is a joint program between UWA Sports (UWA Hockey Academy) and Woodhouse Sports Academy. It comprises one day camps for individual schools hockey players.

We are targeting CCGS, Scotch College, PLC and MLC to conduct trial programs in the July school holidays.

The financial model is yet to be agreed with Trid Woodhouse.

**Module 6 - Coach the Coaches:**

Coordinator – Craig Boyce/Jen Edmonds

UWA Hockey Club Program

This program involves short coaching courses initially for new hockey coaches and/or interested junior parents.

Again the initial program will be conducted within the UWA Hockey Club community and will not generate income.

It may be expanded to include coaching seminars etc.
