J9/10 Umpire Training

Each year UWA junior hockey club train interested J9/10 girls and boys to umpire at a community level. The players participate in a training evening (Wednesday 22nd April: Time to be confirmed), complete an online assessment and are allocated a junior team to umpire on a Saturday morning. The umpires are supported by umpire mentors throughout the season and often share the duties with another J9/10 umpire, so that they umpire every second week. Upon completion of this initial year and a successful assessment, these umpires then go on to umpire for the club or enter the Hockey WA Umpire Accreditation system.

The first step in this process for any J9/10 player who wishes to begin umpiring is to attend the information and training night on Wednesday 22nd April in our clubrooms at UWA. The time will be confirmed with you by your age group coordinator. We hope to see as many of you there as possible and we are lucky enough to have Umpire Trainer Peter Ewing speaking to potential umpires that evening.


