UMPIRE TRAINING

Each season we invite our Year 9's and 10's to participate in our Umpire Training Program. This is an excellent opportunity to umpire junior matches, get feedback each week about how you are going, build community service hours and complete your Level 1 Community Umpiring Accreditation. We have a training night straight after the April holidays and this will be confirmed with you (likely to be Wednesday 26th April straight after 9/10 training). Pizza and drink provided!

How does it work?

- 1. Once you have completed the above training (approx. 1 hour), you are also required to complete an online training module in your own time on the Hockey Australia website.
- 2. You are allocated to a J5/6 or J7/8 team for the season with another trainee umpire. You will then take turns at umpiring this team.











3. You will be provided with a whistle and a set of umpiring cards for you to take to your games. The team that you are allocated to will provide you with an umpiring shirt and an Umpire Mentor to assist you at each game and give you feedback.

Who do I contact?

The club has it's own Umpiring Coordinator. This year Fiona Geddes has taken on this role from Gemma Price. We would like to take this opportunity to thank Gemma for three seasons of commitment and for developing this role over that time. We would also like to welcome Fiona – she will be fantastic!
