

# Player Profile: Chris Bausor

Chris will play his 300th Premier League game for the club on Saturday 23 April . It is a home game against Hale starting at 5-30 pm .

The only other players to achieve this milestone in the men's club are:

Chris played his first game for UWA at the age of 8 in the under 11s.

He played his first PL game in 2005 at the age of 15.

From 2006 he has been an automatic selection in the PL team.

He was captain of the PL team from 2010 to 2019.

He played in the winning premierships teams in 2007 and 2017.

So far he has scored 92 PL goals .

He won the Olympians Medal for the best player in the PL in 2015 and 2016.

He played in the WA Thundersticks team from 2008 to 2017.

He has also played 13 games for Australia.

We thought that we had lost Chris when his work took him to Melbourne in 2020. However he returned just in time to qualify to play in the grand final of that year.

He is now permanently back in Perth and should be available to play for UWA for the foreseeable future.

Chris has an engineering degree from UWA but has never worked as a mainstream engineer.

While still an University he co-founded the business Bar Pop Events and he remains an executive director of the business.

Bar Pop Events is a musical festival promoter . It's major events are Froth Town Beer Festival which is held at the Showgrounds each year in August and the Factory Summer Festival which is held in Northbridge each year in December.

UHC hockey players Ryan Croll and Coby Green also work in the business .

Chris's parents James and Terry have been enthusiastic club supporters for many years . James has been selected to play for Uni Associates in its new over 60s team.

We hope as many supporters as possible can turn up on Saturday 23 April to make the day a great event for Chris and the club.
